Construction and Design Features

Tables

- Constructed of 100% solid oak
- Tabletops have a catalytic finish
 - More durable, much harder than regular lacquer finish
 - Helps protect against spills, stains, nicks and scratches
- Sealed inner edges to prevent warping
- Sealer and grooves on underside to prevent warping and cracking
- Sash locks on all table leaves
- Metal pin top levelers
- Wooden table slides, gear-driven on all pedestals
- Pedestal feet have levelers to adjust for uneven floors
- Aprons constructed of oak plywood
- All leaves have aprons with leaf seam covers
- Carved turned rope design on all aprons
- Arm chairs will fit under all tables
- Leg tables are shipped in 1 carton; all pedestals in 2 cartons

Chairs

- Constructed of 100% solid oak
- All joints reinforced with glue, screws, nails and/or wedges
 - Leg joints glued and screwed to seat bottom
 - Stretchers glued and nailed to legs
 - Backs glued, screwed, nailed and wedged to seat

- All chairs are finished underneath the seat
- All chairs designed with comfort in mind
 - Shaped, saddled seats
 - Contoured backs
 - Deeper tilt
- Most chair styles have matching barstool
- Side chairs ship 2/carton; arm chairs ship 1/carton

Hutch and/or China

- Oak and oak veneers
- Mirrored Back
- Glass doors with brass trim; roller catches on all doors
- Canister lighting
- 3-way touch lighting switch located on the top door hinge
- Molded cornice
- Shaped side panel
- Sectioned glass shelf for ease in removing
- Distinctive brass trim hardware

Buffet

- Oak and oak veneers
- Drawers
 - Dovetailed joint construction
 - Felt-lined plywood bottom
 - Sanded wood sides
 - Side mounted ball bearing metal guides
- Roller catches on all doors
- Adjustable shelf
